#### VII. OLD BUSINESS

#### A. DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEM: Substitute Pay Comparison

Substitute Pay Increase: Sierra Unified last increased substitute teacher pay in July 2019 from \$102.00/day to \$130.00/day. The average substitute pay for a daily rate in Fresno County is approximately \$145.00, with the highest rate at \$208.04/day for teachers In Fresno Unified who do simultaneous teaching. All districts in the Central Valley are experiencing a shortage of qualified substitute teachers. We have increased difficulty over schools in the valley obtaining substitutes given our distance from the substitute pool in the valley. It was recommended that the daily rate for substitute teachers be increased to \$175.00/day, and the long-term substitute rate be raised to \$185.00/day. In a normal year, this increase would add \$59,000 to the budget for substitute teaching.

# B. DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEM: COVID Money – Requests for Additional Supports

Enclosed in the Board packages is a job description for the COVID Assistant position. It is proposed that the position be 6 hours per day, 3 days per week for the remainder of the school year. The cost for the position will be \$28,323 for the 2021-22 school year. We have received a grant from the California Department of Public Health that will pay for this position.

# F. DISCUSSION ITEM: Educator Effectiveness Block Grant

One-time funding provided to county offices of education, school districts, charter schools, and state special schools to provide professional learning for teachers, administrators, paraprofessionals, and classified staff in order to promote educator equity, quality, and effectiveness. LEAs and State Special Schools that receive funding pursuant to California *Education Code (EC)* Section 41480(a) are required to develop and adopt a plan, by December 30, 2021, that delineates the expenditure of funds apportioned including the professional development of teachers, administrators, paraprofessionals and classified staff. The plan shall be presented in a public meeting of the governing board before its adoption in a subsequent meeting.
