VII. OLD BUSINESS

A. ACTION ITEM: Cure and/or Correct pursuant to Government Code section 54960.1 and Reconsideration of Action taken by on January 9, 2017 to Temporarily Modify the Pole Corral Program and Close the Physical Facility.

The Sierra Unified School District is required to follow the Brown Act which regulates many aspects of school district board meetings in open and closed sessions. The Brown Act allows the Board to meet in closed session to discuss significant exposure to and threatened litigation. On January 9, 2017, the Board met to discuss certain circumstances related to Pole Corral Elementary School under an item agendized as "Potential Litigation (Gov. Code 54956.9.)." While the Board properly discussed certain issues related to Pole Corral Elementary School under this item, the Board should have conducted its discussion and voted on the temporary modification of the program, including closing the physical facility, in open session with sufficient notice on the agenda to allow for public comment on the matter.

Under this item the Board will reconsider and vote on that action.

B. INFORMATION: Report and Recommendation from 7-11 Committee Regarding Pole Corral Elementary School

A school district advisory committee was appointed by the Board of Trustees in December 2015, pursuant to Education Code Section 17388. The Board requested that the committee reconvene in January 2017. The purpose of the committee was to review such factors as projected school enrollment, critical financial circumstances, facility conditions, educational program quality, costs of unnecessarily keeping underutilized facilities open, feasible options to closing a school, anticipated fiscal relief from school closure and placement of students from the closed facility.

Based on the information shared with the committee in meetings held February 15, 2017 and March 22, 2017, this committee recommends that Pole Corral Elementary School be closed permanently.
