The Educational Amendments of 1972, otherwise known as Title IX, provides participation opportunities for interscholastic sports for each gender proportionate to the respective rate of enrollment in the school. The rates of participation for both girls and boys in athletic programs should be reasonably proportionate to their respective rates of enrollment. For example, if girls make up 48% of the student body and boys make up 52% of the student body, then 48% of the athletic participants should be girls and 52% should be boys. A margin of plus or minus 5% is considered to be within the acceptable range for compliance.
