



# Sierra Unified School District COVID-19 Student Screening Flow Chart

**Student Presents to Health Office**

*Provide mask if needed*

**Signs and symptoms of COVID-19:** Fever, Cough, Headache, Fatigue, Diarrhea, Nasal Congestion, Myalgia, Sore Throat, Nausea or Vomiting, Shortness of Breath.

**Site LVN Assessment: Verbal:**

Any exposure to someone ill?  
What are your signs and symptoms? When did they start?

**Site LVN Assessment - Visual:**

Flushed cheeks, difficulty breathing, fatigue, extreme fussiness/agitation, coughing.

**Site LVN Assessment - Physical:**

Temperature: > 100° F  
Pulse Oximetry: > 98%

**Visual, Verbal and/or Physical Concerns are Identified by Site LVN**

**No**

LVN Observes for 10 minutes

Is there improvement?

**Yes**

Return to Class

LVN Isolates student and prepares to send home

LVN follows up with student/family, notifies District Nurse of a suspected COVID-19 case

**Yes**

Are symptoms severe? If so, call 911: Trouble breathing; persistent pain or pressure in the chest; new confusion; inability to stay awake, bluish lips or face.

District Nurse to follow up with family regarding return to school following CDC guidelines.

*Symptomatic students will be sent home to isolate according to the FCDH guidance. The remaining students in the classroom will continue with their school day. If the symptomatic student becomes a confirmed positive COVID case, close contacts will be identified and sent home to quarantine according to FCDH guidance.*
