



Sierra Unified COVID-19 Dashboard

Sierra Unified is committed to providing accurate and transparent information regarding COVID-19 cases on our campuses, while also maintaining privacy and confidentiality for our students and staff. The data below represents the number of confirmed COVID-19 cases for students on each campus, and staff across the district that are reported to the district during that week. This data will be updated once per week, on Friday afternoons.

In the event of a positive case, parents of students who need to be quarantined are notified directly by the principal, nurse, or school office staff, and information letters are sent home, which may be via email.

Each person who is impacted by COVID-19 will be contacted directly by their school site, with additional information and directions.

FAQs:

Q: What about the new guidelines from the CDC that says we only need to quarantine for 5 days?

A: The guidelines for students have been updated on the website.

Q: How will I be notified if my child is identified as having been exposed to COVID?

A: You will receive a phone call or an email from the school that should include an attachment letter giving information regarding the situation.

Q: How will I be notified if there is a person that is positive within the school that does not impact my child?

A: If there is a positive within your child’s cohort, that does not impact your child, you will not be contacted.
